House Rules

Hours of Operation

Club House	The club will be open during the times published in the Lee Sheet and on the Club Website. The House Committee, in conjunction with the Club Manager and Food Service Supervisor, will establish the operating hours for the club building, restaurant, bar and pool cantina with the approval of the Governing Board.
Pool	The pool will be open only during regular club hours as published in the Lee Sheet and on the Club Website. The Pool Committee, in conjunction with the Club Manager, will establish the pool's operating hours, with the approval of the Governing Board.

Club Usage

	Members in good standing are entitled to all courtesies and privileges of the club.
	No one under 21 years of age shall sit at the bar.
	No member shall go behind the bar without the permission of the manager.
	The bartender has the right to ask any member or guest who they feel is under the age of 30 for identification.
	The bartender has the right to refuse service to any person who they feel has had too much to drink or is conducting themselves in a disorderly manner.
	All BYC and visiting yacht club members may be asked to show proof of membership by employees of the club (this is to verify use of the club).
	Members must show membership card or show account number in order to make bar or food purchase (at the option of the server).
	Members are encouraged to bring guest to the club in the hopes that these guests will become members; however all members shall follow Article VI Membership and Dues, Section 13. Guest Privileges of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Biloxi Yacht Club when inviting guest to the club.
	No outside food or beverage shall be allowed in the club building or at the club pool.

Member Conduct

	Members shall conduct themselves in an orderly fashion at all times.
	Profanity will not be tolerated and members who violate club rules will be asked to leave the club for the day. Continuous violators will be brought before the board.
	All members, under their obligation of membership, shall report any violations of the House Rules to the manager, commodore or the house committee.
	The bartender on duty is the custodian of the club when the club manager or the commodore is not present. They shall have full authority to act on behalf of the manager.
	Equipment and furnishings of the BYC will be respected at all time. Any damage to same will be paid by the responsible party for the damages.
	Children should be supervised by their parents and the parents shall be responsible for the conduct of their children while at the BYC.

Miscellaneous

	Anyone who is called on the phone, if present, will be reported as present.
	Employees shall be treated with respect; no member has the authority to give instructions to employees or chastise them, if a problem occurs the manager or the highest flag officer present will handle all employee problems.
