Pool Rules

General

	Members and guests are required to sign in.
	Pool privileges are extended to Club members, their immediate family and their guest. Guest must be accompanied by a member. BYC Guest policy as defined in the Constitution will be strictly adhered to.
	No one shall swim alone. The "Buddy System" will be honored. Members 18 and over may swim, without a lifeguard, at their own risk. All persons under 18 must be accompanied by a parent when a lifeguard is not on duty. A maximum of 5 children per parent only. No Exceptions. When a lifeguard is on duty, children 14 through 17 may swim without being accompanied by a parent.
	Non-Swimmers and children 13 and under shall be visibly attended at all times by an able swimmer 18 years or older and delegated to by the parents as being responsible for the swimmer.
	All swimmers must wear appropriate swim attire. No frayed clothing.
	Bottles, glass, and ice chests are not allowed in the pool area
	No food allowed in the pool. Eating is restricted to table areas only.
	Members and guests are not allowed to bring their own beverages to the pool area. Only food approved by the club manager is allowed.
	The lifeguard is to be obeyed and has complete authority. He will use the 10 minute detention rule restricted to the lifeguard station up to expulsion from the pool area for the remainder of the day. This is left to the lifeguard's discretion.
	No wet attire is allowed in the club.
	Group parties must be arranged with the Club Manager with plenty of advanced notice. The members arranging the parties are responsible to see that Pool Rules are enforced. The Club assumes no responsibility for supervision of these parties. Special rules and charges apply when the party involves non-members, including a qualified lifeguard on duty. See the Club Manager for arrangements and charges for group parties.
	The pool is always open to the general membership and members should keep this in mind when scheduling a pool party.
	No one is allowed in the pool unless the club is open.
	All persons entering the pool do so at their own risk.
